The Administrator of Chandigarh (Union Territory) is pleased to appoint Panjab University Chandigarh (hereinafter referred as the University) as the authority competent to conduct Common Entrance Test (CET) and centralized counselling for the B.Ed. course of duration of two academic years for the session 2018-20 in the Colleges of Education situated in Chandigarh and affiliated with Panjab University, Chandigarh.

Accordingly, the following scheme is notified for the information of all concerned:-

3. **ELIGIBILITY**

- a) i) ****Candidates with at least 50% marks either in the Bachelor's Degree and/or in the Master's degree or any other qualification declared equivalent thereto, are eligible for admission to the programme.**

{Candidates with at least 50% marks either in the Bachelor's Degree and/or in the Master's Degree in Science/Social Sciences/Humanity, Bachelor's in Engineering or Technology with specialization in Science and Mathematics with 55% marks or any other qualification equivalent thereto, are eligible for admission to the programme.} **(as taken from the official website of the NCTE)**

- ii) ****The reservation in seats and relaxation in the qualifying marks in favour of reserved categories shall be as per the rules of the concerned Chandigarh Administration.**

{The reservation and relaxation for SC/ST/OBC/PWD and other categories shall be per the rules of the Chandigarh Administration.} **(as taken from the official website of the NCTE)**

****The above norms are as per Para 3.2 of Appendix 4 of N.C.T.E. Notification No. F-51-1/2014-NCTE (N&S) dated 27-11-2014.**

Note-i):- Any Candidates with less than 50% or as desired by NCTE as minimum qualifying marks would not be eligible.

Note-ii):- There shall be a relaxation of 5% marks in favour of SC/BC of candidates. Candidate with less than 45% marks belonging to these categories shall not be eligible.

Provided that such minimum qualifying marks shall not automatically entitle a candidate to get admission in an institution but only entitle the candidate concerned to fulfil other institutional criteria notified by the institution concerned or by the Government concerned from time to time to apply for admission.

- b) Candidate must have studied the major subject of the subject combination for at least three years at Bachelor's level/Master's level. Honours students shall opt for major subject in which they have obtained Honours, the minor subject should have been studied at least for one year / one semester.
- c) Candidates who have appeared for the qualifying examination and whose results have not been declared may be provisionally allowed to apply for Common Entrance Test (CET) at their own risk and responsibility but they shall become eligible for counselling only after they have produced the evidence of having satisfied the above said conditions.
- d) If results in the following cases i.e. Result Late (RL)/ Re-evaluation/Compartment cases, are declared before final counselling, candidature of such persons shall be considered subject to availability of the seats.
- e) In case of students who have done Honours in languages such as Hindi, Punjab and English, the major subject will be language. Such candidates would be allotted minor subject by the college on the basis of other subject option/s permissible to the candidate by the respective University and the availability of the same in the respective college.

4. **PLACEMENT OF CANDIDATES:-**

a) The admission to various Education Colleges of this University & situated in the Union Territory of Chandigarh will be done strictly as per norms laid down by N.C.T.E and by the admission committee to be constituted by the University. The mode of admission shall be determined and notified separately by the University.

However, admission to the seats under 40% (General Pool) will be done as per reservation policy of Chandigarh Administration.

b) When two or more candidates have secured equal marks in the Common Entrance Test (CET) their Inter-se merit admission will be decided on the following criteria in the order of preference:-

(i) Candidate with higher percentage of marks in the qualifying examination.

(ii) Candidate older in age.

5. **DIVISION OF SEATS:-**

Division of Seats into UT Pool and General Pool shall take place as per the Chandigarh Administration Policy. (Chandigarh Administration Policy attached at Annexure 'B').

6. **RESERVATION OF SEATS:-**

Reservation of seats shall be as per the Reservation Policy of Chandigarh Administration. (Chandigarh Administration Policy attached at Annexure 'C').

7. **GENERAL CONDITIONS:-**

- i. The combined merit list will be prepared on the basis of marks secured by the candidates in the Common Entrance Test (CET)
- ii. The minimum qualifying marks in CET will be 25% for General Category Candidates and 20% for SC/ST candidates.
- iii. The University will notify the last date for submission of application forms for the admission and counselling.
- iv. The reservation of seats as given above shall be strictly adhered to. However, in case seats in a reserved category remain vacant, on account of non-availability of qualified candidates, such seats may be filled up from the general category candidates.
- v. The admission of total number of seats in the colleges of education for candidates belonging to different subjects will be done as per the norms laid down by the N.C.T.E as per clause 3.1 of the appendix 4 N.C.T.E. Notification No. F-51-1/2014-NCTE (N&S) dated 27-11-2014.
- vi. Candidates applying for the reserved category shall carefully indicate the claim for **ONLY ONE CATEGORY** in the admission form to be submitted to the University in the first instance before the counselling.
- vii. **NO CHANGE OF CATEGORY OR POOL WILL BE ENTERTAINED/PERMITTED AT A LATER STAGE IN THE APPLICATION FORM.**

- viii. The allocation of college will be made through Centralized counselling by the authorized University.
 - ix. The counselling schedule will be prepared by the admission committee constituted by the Vice-Chancellor of the University.
 - x. All seats in the B.Ed. colleges of Chandigarh will be filled through centralized counselling by the university.
 - xi. After completion of counselling the admission committee will take decision about filling of unfilled seats. The method proposed would be in light of the decisions taken by the Punjab and Haryana High Court regarding C.W.P. No. 19518 dated 14.12.2009. The admission committee would fill all the seats subject to the availability of eligible candidates.
 - xii. In counselling only the major subject would be allotted by the university. The minor subject would be allotted by the college. Allocation of seat does not mean confirmation of admission. The
 - i. admission will be confirmed by the college concerned after checking and verification of documents.
 - xiii. It is the responsibility of the candidate to ensure that correct information is provided when the form is filled online.
 - xiv. Any incorrect information will lead to disqualification.
 - xv. Checking final certificates of the students allocated to the college would be the responsibility of the college.
 - xvi. Whatsoever information the college wants to give to the candidate should be made available on college website as well as in Handbook of Information.
 - xvii. The University shall submit the complete list of admitted candidates to the undersigned with a copy to the Director, Higher Education, Chandigarh Administration within one month of the completion of admission process.
8. **The Schedule for B.Ed. Admissions will be notified/published by the Panjab University, Chandigarh.**
9. **Fees & Funds:**
For admission to private self financed B.Ed. colleges the fee and funds structure will be according to the instruction to be issued by the Chandigarh Administration.

10. In case of any dispute, the decision of the Panjab University, Chandigarh shall be final.
